Report of 14th Annual State Eagle Forum Conference

The 14th annual State Conference for Eagle Forum took place Saturday, June 14th in Costa Mesa, CA, at the beautiful Wyndham Hotel, attended by close to 160 people. It was hosted by the Long Beach Eagle Forum Chapter under the direction of Jeanne Goodin, Chapter President. Orlean Koehle, State President thanked Jeanne and her board for the hard work they put into planning and putting on such an outstanding conference.

The Theme was “Freedom the Force for the Future.” It featured two panels, one on Agenda 21 in the morning and one in the afternoon on Common Core. The special luncheon speaker was to have been Phyllis Schlafly, but unfortunately, Phyllis ended

up in the hospital with emergency back surgery the day before the conference.

Tribute to Phyllis: In her place were three speakers who paid tribute to her life of dedication and service to her country and to the cause of freedom: Janine Hanson, Eagle Forum president from Nevada, who was with Phyllis back in the 1970s when she was fighting the Equal Rights Amendment; Jeanne Goodin, Vice President over Southern California and a founding member of Eagle Forum of California; and Orlean Koehle, President of Eagle Forum of California since 2002. Agenda 21- was presented by four speakers: Debbie Bacigalupi and Orlean Koehle of the Bay Area and Mary Baker and Darcy Brandon from the San Diego area. They told how the UN, using environmental fear tactics, and stealth and deception, were working with federal, regional, State, and local governments to control every aspect of how man interacts with the environment: from the air we breathe, to the water we drink, to the clothes we wear, to the cars we drive, to the energy we use in our own homes that will be controlled and regulated by wireless smart meters.

Orlean told of her book *Just Say No to Big Brother's Smart Meter* and of the two-year battle Eagle Forum members were part of to finally get an opt out of the meters for California.

Regionalism: The panel told of how California is already divided up into 18 regions, how they are using appointed, unelected, regional planning commissioners with sustainable development tactics, such as climate action plans and rezoning to

California Assemblyman Tim Donnelly spoke about the three issues that he is

crowd us all into planned mega "city states" that will even cross national borders.

These tactics will, of course, destroy national sovereignty, destroy our representative form of government, our freedoms, property rights and use of our own resources, such as oil, coal, and water, all under the guise of lowering "greenhouse gas emissions" and supposedly lessening our "carbon footprint."

Debbie told us that in the Western states, they are now introducing wolves that kill hundreds of sheep and calves and help drive more farmers and ranchers off their rural land and into the cities where they can be more easily controlled.

Mary told us that these tactics are now called integrated governance and New Regionalism. Mary has a training program she calls "Citizen Ninja," which has had good results in teaching people effective ways to speak out and be heard.

Education is part of the Agenda 21 Plan. For it to work, children must be thoroughly indoctrinated into the new ideology.

most concerned about: Illegal immigration, 2nd amendment rights, stopping Common Core and getting us back to traditional education. He promised the audience that even though he lost his recent run for governor, he is not giving up and will continue to fight to preserve our freedoms.

Darcy Brandon told how UNESCO is using Common Core worldwide to "restructure society" and indoctrinate our children into believing themselves to be citizens of the world and to have the proper green attitude about sustainable development and earth worship.

Common Core Panel: In the afternoon, five people spoke about Common Core: Orlean Koehle, author and former teacher, who has written two books about it, gave the background – where it really is coming from; Attorney Brad Dacus, president and founder of the Pacific Justice Institute, who created the opt-out form for the assessment tests told of the illegality of such a top-down federal program and the three federal laws it violated; Gloria Pruyne, Director of Orange County Common Core Concerned Citizens told how CC is really education by big corporations and how they will benefit financially; Jeanne Goodin, former elementary school teacher told of the effect of CC on teachers; and Bonnie O'Neil, who serves as So. California Eagle Forum Vice President of Action Alerts, spoke about CC's enormous data collection on students, parents and teachers.

Pastor Rob McCoy was the concluding speaker. He is the senior pastor at Godspcak Calvary Chapel in Thousand Oaks, but he is also a candidate running for the Assembly. He told us how Christians need to get out of the salt shaker and be salt and light in their communities and in the freedom battle.
