Lawsuit Reveals Amazing Data Collection on 10 Million California Students: According to a *Mercury News* article, February 18, 2016, back in 2012, two different groups, Morgan Hill Concerned Parents Association and Concerned Parents Association filed a law suit against the California Department of Education for not abiding by their own laws regarding special education. They stated that there is “widespread, systemic failure by local education agencies for not investigating or enforcing laws ensuring special ed. students were not discriminated against and were provided a proper education.”

In a court order issued by U.S. District Judge Kimberly J. Mueller, as part of the discovery process, the two parent groups’ attorneys have requested to see all student data collected and stored by the state, not just that of special education students.

This data contains “personally identifiable information on students, including children with disabilities, children who requested an assessment or were assessed for special education eligibility, and all children who are attending or have attended a California school at any time since Jan. 1, 2008.” That could be even more than the 10 million originally thought.

What Kind of Data? The article mentions the following: names, Social Security numbers, home addresses, demographics (sex, age, race, ethnicity, religion, family size, occupation of parents, educational level) course information, statewide assessment results, program information, behavior and discipline information, progress reports, special ed. assessment plans, evaluations, individualized education programs, records pertaining to health, mental health and medical, information, student statewide identifiers, attendance, statistics. suspensions. test results. (Continued on p. 2)

Data Also Collected on Teachers: The article also mentions that this same data is also being collected on the teachers.

Response by Various School Districts: As instructed, the superintendents were to write letters to the parents of their students informing them of this lawsuit and the court-ordered sharing of data. Many parents have received some confusing-sounding letters like the following that is coming from Jeffrey P. Felix, Ed. D. Superintendent of Schools, Coronado Unified School District:


*Our district is **NOT** required to disclose any student information, nor does it intend to do so. Nonetheless, as a part of this lawsuit, CDE has been ordered by the court to **release all data it has collected on general and special education students** since Jan. 1, 2008.*

What an interesting statement! Mr. Felix first tells the parents that his district is not required to collect information [data] on the students, nor does it intend to, but in the next breathe he admits that it has been ordered to release all data that it has already collected since 2008. I would say that Mr. Felix speaks with “forked tongue.” He does, however, tell the parents the truth in his final paragraph: *“My disappointment with this legal maneuvering is great, yet the district has **no more power over these proceedings than you do.**”*

Does that sound like local schools and parents are still in control of their children’s education as supposedly they are made to believe? No, It sounds exactly opposite.

Parents are Finally Waking up to the Fact that Data is Being Collected on their Children – Enormous Data! Parents all across the state of California have been writing letters to the judge, to the Superintendent and State Department of Education protesting that data is being collected and is to be soon released. I am not sure what the outcome of all this will be, but I think it is good that it is making some parents aware that such things are actually going on, especially now with Common Core. The newspaper articles are revealing much that the state Department of Education would rather parents did not know about.

The group meets at a Christian Church on Slater Avenue in Huntington Beach for debates on various subjects such as Evolution vs Creationism, Islam vs Christianity. This time the topic was “Global Warming or Climate Change, true or false.”

Orlean and Debbie told how global warming is false based on pseudoscience, with much money to be made (especially from carbon credit trading) with Al Gore as a stock broker. It is money, power and control that keeps the myth alive.

The opponents in the debate were Mark Tabbert, from Citizens Climate Lobby and PhD Berkeley science professor Jerry Lipps.

Orlean started her arguments with a slide that showed the cover of *Time Magazine* back in 1972 announcing a “Big Freeze” and an approaching “ice age.” Seventy additional newspaper and magazine articles came out from other main-line publications saying the same thing until 1980, when it all came to a screeching halt. They just couldn’t make the big breeze fear tactics stick.

So after a few years, in the 1990s began a new myth – the pseudoscience of “global warming,” however, still trying to blame it on the same old reason as for the big freeze - man’s use of fossil fuels, emitting green-house gases (like CO₂) and especially car emissions.

Orlean stated that one needs to use Common Sense in this argument - pointing out that CO₂ is not a pollutant, but is what makes our planet greener. It is essential for life. The plants take in CO₂ and give off O₂. We humans and animals breathe in O₂ and give off CO₂. The more CO₂ the better! If it has as a small rise in the atmosphere as the scientist Jerry Lipp pointed out - it is now .04% instead of .02% - that is even so much better! Orlean also stated that the majority of the atmosphere is water vapor – like 80%. Why get so uptight about the small rise in CO₂?

Orlean also mentioned that a good friend who is a geologist, Jim Moore, whose job was to help discover oil wells in Texas, said that oil is not a finite resource, a “fossil fuel” (created only by the decaying bodies of dead dinosaurs) – that it is part of the earth’s crust and is constantly being re-created. Often the old oil wells that the Texans thought had gone dry would, a few years later, be full of oil again.

Mr. Moore also told her that, as far as he is concerned, all science is now political science. That for a scientist to get a job at a major university today, he must be willing to go along with the politically correct science that is being taught; otherwise, he won’t get the job. That is how global warming is being permeated through our universities and into our public schools. As a substitute teacher, Orlean has seen it being taught in every classroom, no matter if it had anything to do with science or not. That is called indoctrination!

Global Indoctrination, Power and Control: Debbie spoke about the global indoctrination that is being promoted through the UN and Agenda 21, now called Agenda 2030. 'Abortion' was not a strong enough word for what I had witnessed. 'Murder' wasn’t even good enough a word. To me, 'murder' implied that the person might have been capable of fighting back. No, this was a slaughter!”

About FERPA: *“Our current president’s administration is wrongfully paving the way for private entities to buy their way into the personal data of our children and their families. Even more alarming, the U.S. Department of Education is encouraging a radical push from aggregate-level data-gathering to invasive individual student-level data collection.”*



“Common Core’s technological project is “merely one part of a much broader plan by the federal government to track individuals from birth through their participation in the workforce.”

The FERPA law that was supposed to protect student’s privacy was changed by the Obama administration in 2011, so it now allows for data to be shared without parent’s consent or knowledge.

“Dead Harvest” – We encourage you to watch a shocking video on You Tube (<https://youtu.be/AN6ictfDhxA?t=441>), - featuring Congressman Devin Nunes, who represents the Central Valley. It is a 30-minute expose of how California has been intentionally deprived of water.
